HISTORY



Robin Hood is a legendary English outlaw who robs the rich and gives to the poor.

According to legend, he comes from the North of England between 1100 and 1200 during the rule of King Richard I and King John I. He is a good archer and swordsman with green clothes. Some versions of the story say he is a nobleman, while others say he is a normal citizen.

Robin Hood is very loyal to his king, King Richard I (Richard the Lionheart), but he doesn't like the king's brother, Prince John. When King Richard goes to save Jerusalem in the religious wars, the Crusades, Prince John becomes the new king. He is not as kind as his brother. He taxes the poor and Robin Hood starts to fight for the rights of the common people. There are a lot of

ballads, plays, stories and films about this mysterious figure, but the first complete tale about him is "A Gest of Robyn Hode" written in 1510 by an unknown author.



SYNOPSIS



It is 1190. Richard I is king of England. He lives in a castle with his brother, Prince John, and Maid Marion, a young noblewoman.

King Richard decides to fight in the Crusades. He names Prince John the new king and he leaves England for four years.

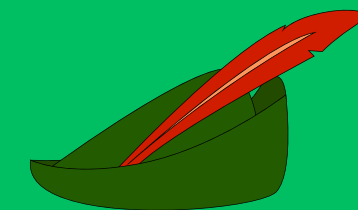
However, King John is a bad king. He doesn't care about the poor people of England and he tells the sheriff to tax the poor so he can become richer. Unfortunately, a lot of people can't pay the taxes and are put into stocks where villagers throw food at them. Maid Marion and Robin Hood think this is unfair. Robin Hood lives in Sherwood Forest near Nottingham. He lives with his friends, the Merry Men. Among them are Little John, Will Scarlett and the monk, Friar Tuck. They think Prince John is an evil king. So they rob the rich people to give money and food to the poor people.



One day they steal some money from the royal coach and with the money they help poor people buy food and warm clothes. King John is furious. The sheriff and the king plan to capture Robin Hood. The sheriff asks Maid Marion to take a message to Robin Hood to invite him to an archery competition in King John's castle. They know Robin is going to accept the invitation and during the competition they plan to capture him and put him in prison.

Maid Marion takes the message to Robin Hood in Sherwood Forest where the Merry Men are busy eating and singing with Friar Tuck. Marion tells Robin she thinks the competition is a trap. Robin is not afraid. On the day of the archery competition the best archers from England, Scotland and Wales participate and of course, Robin Hood, who arrives in disguise at the end and wins the competition. Unfortunately, Prince John and the sheriff recognise him. The guards arrest Robin.

Maid Marion runs through the forest to tell the Merry Men. The Merry Men return to help Robin and they fight the king's guards but they lose and the guards put them into prison. At this moment King Richard returns from the Crusades. He sees that Prince John and the Sheriff are bad and immediately puts them in prison. Robin Hood and all the Merry Men are free and everyone is happy again, including Robin and Marion.

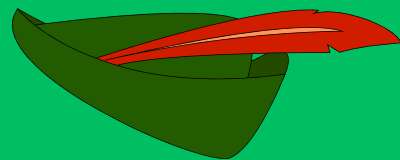

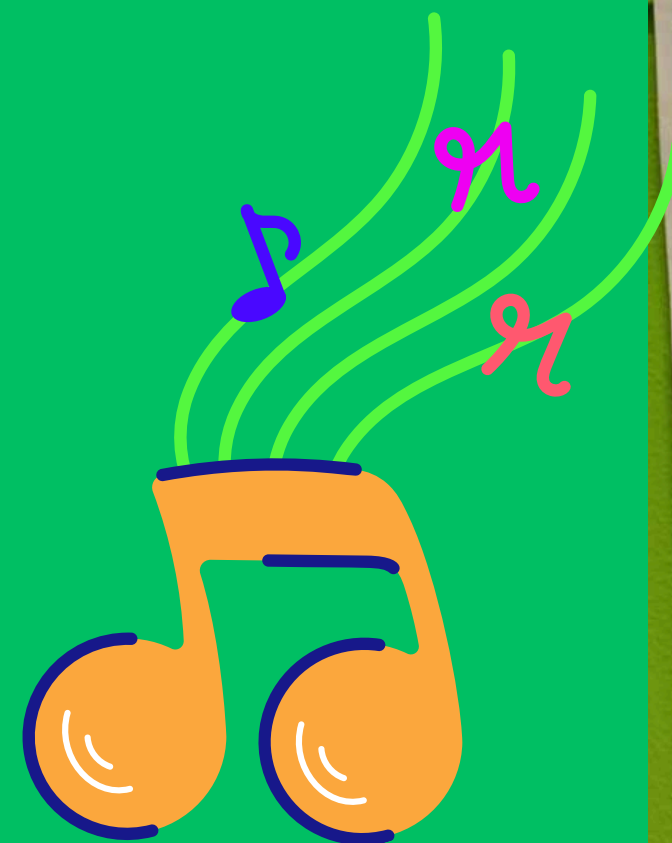

Wine and dine

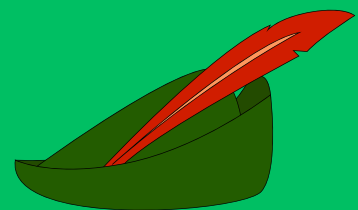
